This is in response to your request under the *Access to Information Act*, which was received by this office on November 23, 2020, to obtain:

*The emails, briefing notes, agendas, minutes, recordings, and list of participants regarding the organization, set-up, and event itself of every meeting of consultation regarding gun confiscation as a result of the Order in Council, PC Number 2020-0298, involving the Royal Canadian Mounted Police with the stated rank, name, tenure, and division of officers and/or members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. This is between the dates of March 20, 2018 to May 11, 2020.*

Based on the information provided, a search for records was conducted with the Canadian Firearms Program and the Commissioner's Office in Ottawa, ON (HQ Division). Unfortunately, we were unable to locate records which respond to your request.

The *Access to Information Act* has established the right of applicants to access federally maintained records. If this particular matter concerned another government, they may have information of interest to you. The *Access to Information Act* does not authorize the RCMP to search files or to disclose information belonging to other government agencies.

Please be advised that you are entitled to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner concerning the processing of your request within 60 days of receipt of this notice. In the event you decide to avail yourself of this right, your notice of complaint should be addressed to:
