Business Development Bank of Canada

Business loans: Financing solutions for entrepreneurs

Business Development Bank of Canada helps small and medium-sized businesses through financing, venture capital and consulting services.

Futurpreneur - Financing + Mentoring

Futurpreneur's programs offer financing, mentoring, and business support for every business stage, focusing on aspiring business-owners aged 18-39. They also provide support for Indigenous entrepreneurs and Black entrepreneurs.

Business and Industry Canada

Business Grants and Financing

Business and Industry Canada offers government grants, loans and financing for businesses, as well as funding for research.

Canada Small Business Financing Program

The Canada Small Business Financing Program has been helping small businesses with their financing needs for over 50 years. Under the program, the Government of Canada makes it easier for small businesses to get loans from financial institutions by sharing the risk with lenders.



Canada Revenue Agency

<u>Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SR&ED) tax incentives</u> The Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SR&ED) tax incentives are intended to encourage businesses to conduct research and development in Canada.

Tax Shelters

The Canada Revenue Agency offers information about tax shelters (investments in property or gifting arrangements) for businesses, including how to register and how to apply for a tax shelter identification number.

Export Development Canada

International Finance Direct

Export Development Canada offers domestic financing to qualified Canadian companies involved in trade-related sectors of the economy.

National Research Council Canada

Financial support for technology innovation through NRC IRAP

The National Research Council's Industrial Research Assistance Program provides financial support to qualified small and medium-sized enterprises in Canada to help them undertake technology innovation.

Natural Resources Canada

<u>Sustainable Development Technology Canada</u> Sustainable Development Technology Canada (SDTC) is a not-for-profit foundation offering funding for Canadian cleantech projects.

Trade Commissioner Service

Funding and support programs for doing international business

The Trade Commissioner Service offers financial support and personalized advice to connect with potential foreign partners, pursue new business opportunities abroad or attract foreign investment into Canadian communities.

Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA): Programs and Initiatives

The Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency provides programs for every need to help Atlantic Canadian businesses become more competitive, innovative and productive and to diversify local economies.

Canada Economic Development for Quebec Regions: Programs

Canada Economic Development for Quebec Regions provides a wide range of programs, services and funding which support the economic development of the regions of Quebec.

Canadian Northern Economic Development Agency (CanNor): Business Development

Federal Economic Development Agency for Northern Ontario (FedNor): Support for businesses

Prairies Economic Development Canada (PrairiesCan): Funding for business and not-for-profits in the Prairie provinces
