

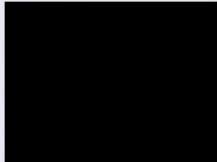

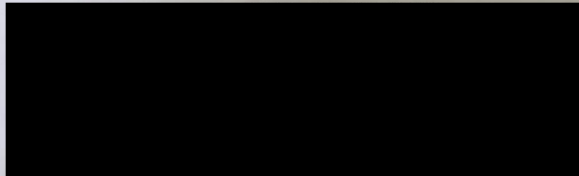
Having completed a thorough search, we regret to inform you that we were unable to locate any records responsive to your request.
